



Garbage Collection Compliance Letter

Dear City Resident:

In order for your garbage collection crew to remove your trash efficiently, economically and safely, the following checked item(s) must be resolved immediately:

- Late garbage. Trash must be placed at the curb by 7:00 A.M. the morning of collection day.
- Tenant(s) must be notified that garbage is not to be put out for collection until their collection day.
- Vehicle(s) parked in front of garbage bags or trash bin on collection day.
- Garbage bags inside fence or property line. Bags need to be brought curbside or edge of road off the property.
- Garbage bags in the ditch line. Bags need to be brought curbside or edge of road off the property.
- Garbage must be placed in a tied bag, wrapped or bundled. Rotten food or maggots will not be collected.
- Garbage contained hide or scraps from hunting, trapping or fishing. **Call the FNSB Landfill at 459-1482 for disposal instructions of these items.**
- Cardboard container was wet and fell apart.
- Boxes must to be folded flat and tied in bundles.
- Bleach on garbage bags- this is hazardous to the garbage collection crew and will not be collected.
- Garbage was disturbed and/or spread by animals. Cover garbage with a tarp or blanket to prevent.
- Loose trash needs to be cleaned out of bin and/or surrounding area.
- Garbage exceeded the maximum 40 pounds per bag limit. There is no limit to number of bags put out.
- Oversized items exceeding 40 pounds, i.e., appliances, furniture, brush, etc.
Please make arrangements with Public Works at 459-6770 for separate collection of oversized items and current large item collection fee pricing.
- Carpet must be rolled and tied and must not exceed 4 feet in length.
- Branches or wood must be cut in 4 foot lengths, bundled securely and tied at both ends.
- Sawdust must be bagged.
- Ashes and/or soot must be placed separately in plastic bags. **Call Public Works at 459-6770 for separate pickup.**
- Fluorescent bulbs must be boxed, maximum 10 per pick up.
- Broken glass must be securely boxed and labeled.-
- Syringes/sharps will not be mixed in with household garbage. Dispose in an approved container or empty plastic jug or bottle with a secured cap or lid and labeled. **Call Public Works at 459-6770 for pick up and/or a container or for specific instructions on disposal of needles.**
- Hazardous material such as petroleum products, **cooking oil**, paint, chemicals, toxic or flammable waste. **Call Public Works at 459-6770 for separate pickup**
- Prohibited Items: the following item(s) will not be collected: automobile parts and tires, tree stumps, demolition material, sod, brick, stone, radioactive substances, appliances containing refrigerant gas. **Call the FNSB Landfill at 459-1482 for disposal instructions of these items.**
- Garbage contained animal waste/kitty litter
- Bin is built improperly, in a state of disrepair or unsanitary.
- Bin is turned in the wrong direction to access doors for collection.
- Repeated non-compliance subject to additional charge on billing
