

RESOLUTION NO. 4655

**A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO DOWL, LLC FOR DESIGN
WORK FOR THE GATEWAY SUBDIVISION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$250,020.00**

WHEREAS, in accordance with FGC Section 54-207 (Architectural, Engineering, and Land Surveying Contracts) DOWL, LLC, was selected by the City Engineer as the most qualified and suitable firm of demonstrated competence to perform design work for the Gateway Subdivision Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, DOWL, LLC, was previously awarded a competitive contract with the City of Fairbanks in the amount of \$113,100 as the responsive firm with the highest qualifications to perform the preliminary design work (FB-14-24); and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer would like to amend the contract with DOWL, LLC in the amount of \$136,920 to prepare the design plans, specifications, and construction cost estimate; and

WHEREAS, the total contract amount will now exceed \$250,000 and City Council approval is required; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project is provided to the City of Fairbanks through the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development Designated Legislative Grant Program and no match is required;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Fairbanks,

SECTION 1. That the quote by DOWL, LLC in the amount of two hundred fifty thousand, twenty dollars and zero cents (\$250,020.00) is hereby approved for award.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract and such other documents in a form approved by the City Attorney as may be necessary to effect award of the contract.
