**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO ACCEPT
THE FFY2015 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)**


WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks has been notified by the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development that the City was awarded \$850,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks was awarded funds to complete phase one of the Bjerremark Subdivision revitalization project to construct traffic-calming, beautification, pedestrian and defensible space measures; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks is providing a match in the amount of \$300,000 for planning and designing costs funded through the Designated Legislative Grant Program funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required for accepting funds on behalf of the City for this grant.




