
**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE BILL OF RIGHTS
AND CIVIL LIBERTIES**

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks recognizes the Constitutions of the United States of America and the State of Alaska to be the law of the land which all public servants are sworn to uphold and defend; and

WHEREAS, the first Ten Amendments to the U. S. Constitution, commonly referred to as the Bill of Rights, reserve to the people the free exercise and enjoyment of certain fundamentally-ordered civil liberties and inalienable rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS that the City of Fairbanks remains firmly committed to the protection of human rights and civil liberties for all people as set forth in the Bill of Rights of the Constitution of the United States.
