**INCIDENT:** Bojangles Shooting Update

The Fairbanks Police Department, with assistance from the Alaska State Troopers and Anchorage Police Department, arrested JOSHUA JERMAINE HAYNES (DOB 10/12/1988) and GABRIELLE PATRICE HAYES (DOB 7/16/1984) on charges of Misconduct Involving Weapons.

Specialist 4<sup>th</sup> Class TEVYN ALONZA DAVIS (DOB 5/10/1994) who is an active duty soldier at Fort Wainwright, was also arrested on a charge Murder in the Second degree. The arrests stemmed from their involvement in the shooting at Bojangles night club on September 5, 2016.

On Monday, March 13, 2017, the Fairbanks Police Department obtained arrest warrants for J. HAYNES, G. HAYNES, and DAVIS, as well as three search warrants for residences in the City of Fairbanks. At approximately 2:45p.m., at the request of FPD detectives, the Alaska State Troopers B Detachment coordinated a traffic stop at mile 81 of the Parks Highway and transported G. HAYNES and DAVIS to Anchorage Police Department. FPD Detectives flew to Anchorage to question both suspects.

At approximately 5:45p.m., the Fairbanks Police Department Tactical Police Team was able to locate and arrest J. HAYNES on Davis Road. J. HAYNES was transported to the Fairbanks Correctional Center. The FPD Tactical Team and Alaska State Troopers SERT Team then served the three residential search warrants.
