INCIDENT: Vehicle vs Pedestrian Hit and Run

At approximately 1240pm, Fairbanks Police responded to Kathryn Avenue and Bunnell Street for a report of a Motor Vehicle Collision with Injuries, Vehicle versus Pedestrian. As officers arrived, witnesses reported that the vehicle fled the scene. The vehicle was described as a dark colored Chevrolet or GMC SUV or pickup truck with large tires. The vehicle has possible damage to the front and/or passengers side.

The victim is a 44-year old female who was walking north on Kathryn Avenue towards College Road. Fairbanks Fire Department responded and the female was transported to the Fairbanks Memorial Hospital with life threatening injuries.

The Fairbanks Police Department is still looking for the suspect vehicle.
