AS 40.25.120. Public Records; Exceptions; Certified Copies.

- (a) Every person has a right to inspect a public record in the state, including public records in recorders' offices, EXCEPT
- (6) records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of the law enforcement records or information
- (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings;
 - (B) would deprive a person of a right to fair trial or an impartial adjudication;
 - (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwanted invasion of the personal privacy of a suspect, defendant, victim, or witness;
 - (D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of a confidential source;
 - (E) would disclose confidential techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions;
 - (F) would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if the disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law; or
 - (G) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of an individual.

AS 12.61.110. Confidentiality of Victim and Witness Addresses and Telephone Numbers.

The residence and business addresses and telephone numbers of a victim of a crime or a witness to a crime are confidential. A report, paper, picture, photograph, court file, or other document that relates to a crime and contains the residence or business address or telephone number of a victim or witness, and that is in the custody or possession of a public officer or employee, may not be made available for public inspection unless the residence and business addresses and telephone numbers of all victims and witnesses have been deleted.
