### ***STEWART STREET SHOOTING***

**FAIRBANKS, Alaska**

Tuesday evening at approximately 10:25 p.m., Fairbanks Police Officers responded to the 1000 block of Stewart Street for a report of gunfire in the area. A caller reported four to five shots had been fired and a vehicle was observed speeding from the area. With officers responding the 911 dispatch center received a call reporting a male victim, with multiple gunshot wounds, had been dropped off at Fairbanks Memorial Hospital. The victim was identified as 28 year old Lawrence Lee Perdue. Perdue's family has been notified and he is still at the hospital receiving treatment for his injuries. No update on his status is available at the time of this release.

The suspicious vehicle was described as an older model (no later than 2000) two door silver sedan. Officers found shell casings from the apparent gunfire and broken glass at the scene. It is unknown whether the glass possibly came from the vehicle that dropped Mr. Perdue off at the hospital or another vehicle involved in the incident. No vehicle(s) have been located at this time.

Detectives are actively working the case to determine motive behind the shooting. There is no additional information at the moment and no other parties involved have been identified.
