



PRESS STATEMENT-Motor Vehicle Collision

FAIRBANKS, Alaska

On 04/06/16 at 1423 hours Fairbanks Police Department responded to the intersection of Cowles Street and 21st Avenue for the report of a motor vehicle collision involving injuries. The collision involved an orange Subaru Crosstrek and a Honda dirt bike. The Subaru was driven by 30 year old Eliza Cink of Fairbanks. Cink was uninjured in the collision. The driver of the dirt bike was identified as 22 year old Clayton Nelson of Fairbanks. He sustained a leg injury and was transported to Fairbanks Memorial Hospital. The passenger of the dirt bike was identified as 20 year old Lakeisha Nollner-Albert of Fairbanks. Nollner-Albert sustained serious incapacitating injuries and was also taken to Fairbanks Memorial Hospital. Neither occupant of the dirt bike were wearing helmets and both were ejected during this collision.

When Officers arrived on scene bystanders were attending to Nollner-Albert. Preliminary investigation revealed the Subaru was traveling east on 21st Avenue. The Honda dirt bike was traveling south on Cowles Street. The driver of the Subaru reportedly stopped for a stop sign at the intersection, looked both directions and upon pulling into the roadway collided with the Honda dirt bike.

The roadway has been blocked off while officers conduct an extensive investigation into this incident.
