

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED INITIATIVE

PURPOSE: To prohibit the operation of marijuana businesses in the City of Fairbanks.

PROPOSED INITIATIVE

A CITY OF FAIRBANKS VOTER INITIATIVE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF MARIJUANA BUSINESSES IN THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS

WHEREAS, the residents of Alaska passed Ballot Measure No. 2 (Petition ID: 13PSUM), “An Act to tax and regulate the production, sale, and use of marijuana,” codified as Alaska Statute Chapter 17.38; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure No. 2 creates classes of registrations, licenses, or permits to enable the lawful conduct of certain types of marijuana commerce and business; and

WHEREAS, the conduct of these commercial and business activities is unlawful without the appropriate registration, license, or permit; and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 17.38.210(a) empowers local governments to prohibit the operation of these businesses by enactment of an ordinance or voter initiative.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY INITIATIVE OF THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS, ALASKA, as follows:

Section 1: This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Fairbanks General Code.

Section 2: The City of Fairbanks hereby adopts, in the Code of Ordinances, a new provision titled Chapter 14, Article VI, Marijuana Businesses, which shall state that all marijuana businesses, acts, or commerce subject to registration, licensure, or permit pursuant to Alaska Statute Chapter 17.38 are prohibited in the City of Fairbanks.

Section 3. If a majority vote favors this ordinance, it shall become effective upon certification of the election.
