Sec. 86-77. Application for chauffeur's license.

All applications for issuance or renewal of a chauffeur's license shall be made upon forms provided for this purpose by the city clerk, and the applications shall be submitted to the city clerk for review. The applicant shall also submit a current criminal history report obtained from the state department of public safety if a state resident or, if not, a current record obtained from the state of residency, and a current driving record. The requirements to be fulfilled prior to issuance of a chauffeur's license shall be as follows:

- (1) The applicant must be 21 years of age or older, and furnish proof if requested.
- (2) The applicant must be able to read, write and speak the English language.
- (3) The applicant must be in possession of a current Alaska State Driver's License.
- (4) The applicant must not have had a conviction within 24 months of:
- a. A moving traffic violation which results in suspension or revocation of the applicant's driver's license pursuant to AS 28.15.221 through 28.15.261;
 - b. Reckless or negligent driving;
 - c. Driving while license is limited, suspended or revoked:
- (5) The applicant must not have had his driver's license suspended or revoked within two years prior to the application date.
- (6) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the applicant must not have had a felony or misdemeanor conviction within ten years of:
 - a. Prostitution or promotion of prostitution;
- b. Sale, transportation, possession or use of any controlled substance as defined in AS 11.71.140 through 11.71.190;
- c. Any felony or misdemeanor which includes as an element the use of threat of force upon a person;
 - d. Burglary, felony larceny, fraud or embezzlement;
 - e. Any sexual offense;
 - f. Any homicide or assault involving operation of a motor vehicle;
 - g. Two separate felony convictions of any type:
 - h. Operation or driving a vehicle while intoxicated (five years);
 - i. Refusal to submit to a chemical test as defined in AS 28.35.032 (five years).
 - (7) The applicant must not be addicted to the use of intoxicants or narcotics.
- (8) The applicant must be of good moral character and repute, to be evidenced by two affidavits of respectable citizens who personally know the applicant. (Code 1960, § 8.201(c)(1)--(6); Ord. No. 5484, § 1, 5-11-2002; Ord. No. 5562, § 1, 3-13-2004)





ORDINANCE NO. 5849

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FGC 82-1 TO PROHIBIT THE ADDITION OF FLUORIDE TO COMMUNITY WATER SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, City Code has required the addition of fluoride to the community water system since 1959; and

WHEREAS, in response to questions about the benefits and risks of fluoride, the City Council created the Fairbanks Fluoride Task Force to study the issue and make recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Fluoride Task Force had advanced degrees and knowledge in the fields of chemistry, geochemistry, microbiology, medicine and dentistry; and

WHEREAS, after an exhaustive inquiry and over a year of public hearings, research and analysis, the Task Force issued a report with recommendations as follows:

The Fairbanks Fluoride Task Force makes a set of four recommendations. We anticipate that the community's focus will be on Recommendation #1, but as a committee we feel strongly that Recommendations 2, 3, and 4 should be implemented along with Recommendation #1 as part of a cohesive plan to address dental health issues in our community.

1. Primarily because (1) the ground water used for Fairbanks public water contains an average of 0.3 ppm fluoride, and (2) higher concentrations of fluoride put non-nursing infants at risk, the task force recommends that supplemental fluoridation of the Fairbanks public water supply be terminated. The task force further recommends that the Fairbanks community be informed of possible dental health implications from not fluoridating the water.

Rationale: Not fluoridating Fairbanks water will reduce the fluoride content from 0.7 ppm to 0.3 ppm, which is the fluoride concentration of the raw water used by Golden Heart Utilities (GHU). This will reduce, but not eliminate, the risk of significant incidence and severity of fluorosis, especially fluorosis associated with the use of GHU water to prepare infant formula. Doing so will also address ethical concerns raised during the task force's public testimony. However, the effect of this reduction in fluoride concentration on the caries rate in the Fairbanks community, while most likely small, is unknown and unpredictable. Those who depend on 0.7 ppm fluoride in tap water for their dental health need to be informed of the possible adverse consequences to their dental health caused by reducing the fluoride content of Fairbanks tap water from 0.7 ppm to 0.3 ppm and of the measures that can be taken to address these possible adverse consequences.

The task force has made this recommendation to terminate fluoridation of GHU water with full knowledge of and respect for the positions of the American Dental Association (ADA), the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC; part of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services), the World Health Organization, and the Alaska Department of Public Health in support of fluoridation of public water supplies. While the task force members agree that water fluoridation may be an important element of an effective dental health program in many communities, the majority of members are not convinced that it is necessary in Fairbanks because of the fluoride content of the city's ground water and the alternate sources of fluoride available in the community.

Five task force members, with various degrees of conviction, support this recommendation, while one member (Dr. Taylor) supports continuing fluoridation at 0.7 ppm.

2. The Fairbanks City Council's decision-making process on fluoridation should involve representatives of the Fairbanks North Star Borough government.

Rationale: At least 25% of area residents who receive GHU water reside outside the city limits.

3. Local dentists and physicians should be encouraged to provide their patients with up-to-date information on the benefits and risks associated with fluoride.

Rationale: If nothing else, the recent notice that the secretary of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services has proposed a new recommendation on fluoridation of public water supplies indicates that the citizenry should be informed about the state of contemporary research findings and analysis related to the role of fluoride in dental health. All of the members of the task force went into this project with incomplete and in some cases incorrect information about the issue. We suspect that we are not unique in that respect.

4. The Fairbanks City Council should encourage the local school system to review and modify, as appropriate, its approach to promoting good dental health practices.

Rationale: The local schools have an excellent opportunity to help all families in the community to learn about and to implement good dental health practices, which can include optional opportunities at school for topical fluoride treatment (in the form of rinses and tooth brushing, for example) as well as techniques for minimizing unnecessary and/or unwanted exposure to fluoride.

WHEREAS, the Fairbanks North Star Borough Assembly has been notified of the Task Force report.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS, ALASKA, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Fairbanks General Code Sections 82-1 is amended as follows (new text in <u>underlined bold font</u>, deleted text in <u>strikeout font</u>):

Ordinance No. 5849 Page 2

Sec. 82-1. City Community water systems fluoridated.

A source of fluoride ion, approved by the state department of health, shall be added to the water supply of the city under the rules and regulations of the state department of health, such addition to be administered by Golden Heart Utilities, Inc. in a manner approved by the environmental coordinator of the city

- a. Water utilities that own or operate community water distribution systems in the City shall not add fluoride, in any form, to the water system.
- b. The operators of community water distribution systems within the City of Fairbanks shall provide a copy of the annual water quality report, called the Consumer Confidence Report, to the City. The report shall be filed with the City Clerk and available for public inspection.

<u>Section 2.</u> A display advertisement shall be published providing information about the Fluoride Task Force recommendations, including information about where a full copy of the report can be obtained. In addition, information shall be sent to the Fairbanks North Star Borough School District.

<u>Section 3.</u> The City recognizes that the Golden Heart Utilities, the operator of the community water system providing water in the City, will need regulatory approval from the State of Alaska for the water treatment process changes before discontinuing fluoridation. It is expected that this approval can be obtained by the end of 2011. Therefore, while GHU is encouraged to implement the change as soon as possible, this ordinance shall be effective the 1st day of January 2012.

ORDINANCE NO. 5850

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONVEYANCE OF THE J.P. JONES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CENTER TO THE INTERDENOMINATIONAL MINISTERIAL ALLIANCE OF FAIRBANKS

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks is owner of the land and building located at 2400 Rickert Street, known as the J.P. Jones Community Development Center, situated on the Ease ½, Block 32, Bjerremark Subdivision, as shown on attached "Exhibit A", and;

WHEREAS, said property has historically required management, maintenance and repair by the City with no offsetting lease revenues; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to divest facilities which are not part of the City's core mission; and

WHEREAS, the facility has been leased to the Interdenominational Ministerial Alliance of Fairbanks since June, 1985, which lease expires January 31, 2014; and

AGREEMENT FOR TRANSFER OF THE J.P. JONES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CENTER

FROM THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS

TO THE INTERDENOMINATIONAL MINISTERIAL ALLIANCE OF FAIRBANKS, ALASKA

WHEREAS, the City desires to divest itself of facilities which are not part of the City's core mission, and which draw upon City resources; and

WHEREAS, the Interdenominational Ministerial Alliance of Fairbanks (the "IMA") has leased the J.P. Jones Community Development Center from the City since 1985, and is familiar with use and operation of the facility; and

WHEREAS, the IMA has expressed its desire to assume ownership of said facility, including land and building; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by Ordinance 5850, with effective date of June 11th, 2011, has authorized conveyance the facility to the IMA, subject to certain conditions.

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Fairbanks ("City") and the IMA hereby agree to the following conditions of transfer:

- a. Conveyance of the property will be made by Warranty Deed, which will contain the use conditions stated in Ordinance 5850.

- c. Existing grant funds. Two funding sources are available for further improvements to the facility.
 - 1. HUD grant funds in the approximate balance of \$80,543
 - 2. Energy grant funds in approximate balance of \$5.100

These grant funds are obligated to the City and cannot be transferred to the IMA. Therefore, the City, in cooperation with the IMA, shall identify improvements to the facility, administer and construct the improvements, and expend the grant funds to the extent practical before transfer of the property.

- d. Enterprise Fund: The City holds a cash account for the benefit of the J.P. Jones Community Development Center in the approximate balance of \$137,282. These funds will be transferred to the IMA upon conveyance of the facility.
- e. The City will turn over any keys or key cards in its possession, together with such documents and information related to the facility available.
- f. The City will provide technical support and training to the IMA for facility systems prior to the conveyance.
- g. Transfer of the property shall be "as-is, where is", as exists on the date of conveyance.
- h. After transfer is complete, the IMA shall assume all responsibility and liability for ownership and operation of the facility, without further assistance from the City, and without limitation.



- 1. State grant funds in balance of \$80,543
- 2. Energy grant funds in approximate balance of \$5,100

These grant funds are obligated to the City and cannot be transferred to the IMA. Therefore, the City, in cooperation with the IMA, shall identify improvements to the facility, administer and construct the improvements, and expend the funds before transfer of the property.

- d. Enterprise Fund: The City holds a cash account for the benefit of the J.P. Jones Community Development Center in the approximate balance of \$137,282. These funds will be transferred to the IMA upon conveyance of the facility.
- e. The City will turn over any keys or key cards in its possession, together with such documents and information related to the facility available.
- f. Transfer of the property shall be "as-is, where is".
- g. After transfer is complete, the IMA shall assume all responsibility and liability for ownership and operation of the facility and will operate and maintain the facility for the practical life of the building and will not look to the City of Fairbanks or the State of Alaska to operate or maintain the facility or pay for its operation or maintenance.

RESOLUTION NO. 4474

A RESOLUTION FIXING THE RATE OF TAX LEVY FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE 2011 REAL PROPERTY TAX OF THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the real property assessment rolls have been completed and the Fairbanks North Star Borough Assessor's Office has advised the City Mayor that the net taxable value of real property as defined by AS 29.71.800 within the City of Fairbanks, Alaska, is estimated at \$2,412,601,885.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS, ALASKA, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the rate of levy on the net assessed value of taxable real property is hereby fixed at 5.843 mills for municipal purposes within the City of Fairbanks. The 5.843 mill rate as provided in Fairbanks Charter Section 6.5 is comprised of three parts:

General Fund Expenditures:	4.900 mills
Police Station Bond Payments:	0.288 mills
Claims & Judgments:	0.655 mills

<u>Section 2</u>. That taxes levied hereby are due, delinquent and subject to penalties and interest as provided by FGC Chapter 74, Article II, City of Fairbanks, Alaska.

Section 3. Taxes in any given year may be paid in two equal installments. The first half of taxes thus levied shall be due on the first day of September in the year in which the taxes are levied and are delinquent if not paid prior to the close of business on that day. The second half of taxes thus levied shall be due on the first day of November in the year in which the taxes are levied and are delinquent if not paid prior to the close of business on that day.

<u>Section 4</u>. The sections, paragraphs, sentences and clauses and phrases of this Resolution are severable. Should any part of this Resolution be declared unconstitutional or otherwise unlawful by a valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or unlawfulness shall not affect any of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and phrases of this Resolution.
