APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

a) Regular Meeting Minutes of February 3, 2021.

Chair Kilbourn asked for corrections to the minutes. **Ms. Heredia** noted that under Item (c) of Unfinished Business that her name is referenced, and it should be Ms. Dowling. The correction was noted by Deputy Clerk Rodak.

Deputy Clerk Rodak advised the Chair to hear a motion to approve the minutes. **Chair Kilbourn** indicated that a motion was not necessary.

Chair Kilbourn took a voice vote on the motion to APPROVE the Meeting Minutes, as Corrected, and all members voted in favor.

Ms. Dowling, seconded by **Mr. Gibson**, moved to APPROVE the Agenda.

COMMUNICATIONS TO THE COMMISSION

a) Email from Noel Wien Public Library

Deputy Clerk Rodak stated that an email had been received from a Ms. Kitty Berner requesting an electronic copy of the Clay Street Burial List and asked for direction on how to proceed.

Chair Kilbourn stated that the version in the Clerk's Office did not have the most recent information. She added that she would reach out to Ms. Berner and bring a flash drive with the most recently updated burial list to the City. Deputy Clerk Rodak stated that she would forward the email from Ms. Berner to Chair Kilbourn.

Ms. Heredia proposed that the information provided to the library should be protected so that the document could not be altered.

Chair Kilbourn indicated that she would provide them with an updated paper copy. Deputy Clerk Rodak clarified that the request was for a digitized version. **Chair Kilbourn** stated that she did not want to provide a digital copy due to the frequent changes. Deputy Clerk Rodak stated that she would forward the email and wait for Chair Kilbourn's direction.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

a) Pioneer Foundation Letter Update

Chair Kilbourn read the response from the Pioneer Foundation stating that they would discuss donating funds for Pioneer member markers at their March 9, 2021 meeting. She went on to state that she had provided a list to the Foundation and asked them to choose how many markers they would be willing to purchase at \$250 each. She added that the markers would indicate the membership to the Igloo Foundation and would be ordered this year with credit given to the Foundation for purchase of the markers.

Mr. Dalton asked if the markers would include the Pioneer logo. **Chair Kilbourn** stated that she was unsure if that was possible but would check with Ms. Jones.

Mr. Dalton stated that it would be important to recognize the correct order of Igloo as women belong to #8.

Chair Kilbourn stated that the Commission would order the markers at the direction of the Foundation, giving credit to the funding source. She added that the Foundation would be performing some of their own research to determine which of the names qualified as members, as some of the names were only briefly mentioned in old newspaper articles.

b) Clay Street Write-Ups

Chair Kilbourn stated that she had not received any new requests for different names to write about and reminded everyone that they can receive a new name by sending her an email.

OPEN AGENDA

a) May Meeting Reminder: Meeting to be held at the Cemetery shed in order to hang Frank Turney's plaque and to plan the Summer 2021 work to be done in the northern section.

Mr. Gibson asked about the plaque, and **Chair Kilbourn** stated that she would provide him with a picture of it.

Mr. Jacobson described the picture of Frank that is on the plaque and stated that the plaque includes a short description including his contributions.

[We have no record of William Pendergraft being a member of Igloo 4.]

We included the plot and grave number and hope you will include this information on the head stone. It helps enormously as a guide and reference point for anyone looking for and finding a specific grave.

Additionally, the Board requests that the Commission will check on the possibility to clean and re-chisel the inscription on the graves with original slabs. We have a number of stone masons and businesses in Fairbanks who deal with concrete. This action, if possible, will keep the historic markers as is and for many more years to come.
