Dear Resident/Business Owner,

Snow removal is a team effort between residents and Public Works. We all have important roles to play. If your home or business borders a sidewalk please make the effort to keep the sidewalk clear of snow and ice as required by City Code 70-321. Snow cleared from sidewalks can be placed curbside in the street.

Additionally, City Code prohibits the removal of snow from private property and placing it on sidewalks and streets, or in right of ways if it interferes with snow removal operations, garbage collection, drainage systems, mail delivery, newspaper delivery, line of sight at intersections, or the rights of other property owners. By removing snow responsibly, you will avoid additional charges and fines.

The City retains the right to utilize the right of ways for public purposes. This right does not extend to adjacent private property owners to move or store snow in the right of way that borders property that they do not own.

Public Works plows and berms priority roads first, then on a rotational basis in neighborhoods. Snow berm removal operations occur on an as needed basis. Depending on snowfall, weather and availability of snow crews and equipment snow plowing and removal times will vary. Please check the City Website for updates.
