## A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE SOLE SOURCE BID OF MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC. FOR REPLACEMENT OF DISPATCH RADIO CONSOLES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,214,130

WHEREAS, in accordance with FGC Section 54-46 a sole source vendor was identified for the radio console upgrade for the Fairbanks Emergency Communications Center (FECC); and

WHEREAS, the FECC is the only communications center in interior Alaska equipped to communicate on all local emergency service Alaska Land Mobile Radio (ALMR) talk groups and conventional radio frequencies necessary to provide E911 and dispatch services to multiple police, fire and EMS agencies throughout the region; and

WHEREAS, the FECC has been notified that the current radio consoles will be inoperable in 2015 due to incompatibility as a result of a statewide ALMR upgrade; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice has approved Motorola Solutions, Inc. as a sole source vendor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks received a grant from the United States Department of Justice in the amount of \$666,481, has budgeted \$490,488 in Capital Funds, and will receive \$57,161 from the Fairbanks North Star Borough:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council that the Mayor is authorized to execute a contract in a form satisfactory to the grantor and City Attorney with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for the radio console upgrade for the Fairbanks Emergency Communications Center in an amount not to exceed one million, two hundred fourteen thousand, one hundred thirty dollars and no cents (\$1,214,130.00).
