A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS AND FOUNTAINHEAD DEVELOPMENT INCORPORATED

WHEREAS, Fountainhead Development, Inc. (Fountainhead) has requested that the Alaska Department of Transportation include landscaping (trees, shrubs and mulch) in a large, unused portion of public right-of-way along the west side of Margaret Street as part of the upcoming Margaret Avenue/Antoinette Avenue Intersection Reconstruction/Realignment Project; and

WHEREAS, this section of Margaret Street is the only road accessing Joy School, several residential homes, and Fountainhead's 105-acre Wedgewood Resort, Antique Auto Museum; and a 2,000-acre migratory waterfowl refuge, which are frequented by residents and visitors to Fairbanks; and

WHEREAS, the Antique Auto Museum collection features over 80 vehicles, including horseless carriages, steamers, electric cars, speedsters, cycle-cars, midget racers and 30's classics. These include such rarities as an 1898 Hay Motor Vehicle, 1906 Compound, 1920 Argonne and 1921 Heine-Velox Victoria, including several vehicles that are traced to the founding and development of Fairbanks; and

WHEREAS, Fountainhead is committing to take over full maintenance of the landscaping area per the attached assignment agreement, and the cost for constructing the landscaping is being provided by the project budget with no cost impact or match contribution required by the City of Fairbanks;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Fairbanks, Alaska, that it authorizes the City Mayor to execute an assignment of landscape maintenance agreement with Fountainhead.

ASSIGNMENT OF LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

The City of Fairbanks, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Alaska, with address of 800 Cushman Street, Fairbanks, Alaska 99701 (the City), and Fountainhead Development, Inc., 1501 Queens Way, Fairbanks, Alaska 99701 (Fountainhead), recite and declare:

RECITALS

1. It is anticipated that the City will be the obligated party under a Maintenance Agreement between the City and the Alaska Department of Transportation, to wit:

- 2. Under this Agreement, the City would assume maintenance of those landscaped areas of the Project lying north of the north right of way limit of College Road and between the eastwest right of way limits of Margaret Avenue, Fairbanks, Alaska, as shown on attached "Exhibit B."
- 3. The Project is scheduled for construction sometime in the next three years and specifies "hard surface" gravel landscaping only.
- 4. It is the desire and intent of Fountainhead to upgrade the proposed landscaping by planting trees, shrubs, grass, annuals, and a decorative vintage truck planter, all as shown on attached "Exhibit C," and to bear the cost for construction and maintenance of these upgrades.

THEREFORE, in consideration of these recitals and for other good and valuable consideration in hand paid, the City and Fountainhead agree to the following:

- 1. <u>Assumption of Maintenance Agreement</u>: Fountainhead agrees to assume and does assume all rights and obligations of the City described under "A" above and agrees and promises to faithfully perform all obligations of the City, specifically including construction and maintenance of landscape upgrades as shown on said "Exhibit C".
 - 2. Duration: This agreement shall be of indefinite duration.
- 3. <u>Termination</u>: This agreement may be terminated by Fountainhead without cause or by the City with cause, either party providing sixty days written notice to the other.

III. The City agrees to the following:



IV. It is mutually agreed that:

- The above parties will coordinate and participate in the review of the final design plans prior to construction. Each party will give special attention to elements of the project that result in future maintenance responsibilities covered under this agreement.
- The above parties will ensure through the design and construction of the project that all permanent or semi-permanent landscape objects be placed no closer than 4' from the back of the sidewalk on College Road.

- The above parties will coordinate and participate in the Final Inspection of the
 construction project. The purpose of this inspection is to ensure that the project is
 constructed in reasonable conformance with the design plans in preparation for
 acceptance of maintenance responsibilities.
- Each party agrees that it will be responsible for its own acts and results thereof, and each party shall not be responsible for the acts of the other agency.
- Each party will comply with all applicable laws, regulations and executive orders.
- This agreement may be revised as needed by the issuance of a written amendment that is agreed to and signed by the affected parties.


