A RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE ALASKA HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE FOR FFY2015 TRAFFIC SAFETY PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks has received supplemental funding from the Alaska Highway Safety Office (AHSO) for local law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the City has received positive citizen feedback regarding continued traffic enforcement, particularly in the apprehension of DUI offenders; and

WHEREAS, the City is applying to retain two dedicated DUI Traffic Enforcement employees for wages and benefits in the amount of \$261,512, and a required match of in-kind support in the amount of \$261,512 will be provided; and

WHEREAS, the City is eligible to receive \$24,000 to participate in High Visibility Enforcement activities to reduce accidents and injuries by impaired drivers by conducting seat belt and DUI enforcement, and no match is required; and

WHEREAS, the City is eligible to receive \$10,000 to attend highway safety conferences and events, and no match is required; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to request a total of \$295,512 from Alaska Highway Safety Office and provide a match of \$261,512 with currently budgeted City staff expenditures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor is authorized to accept and execute any and all documents required for requesting and expending funds on behalf of the City for these projects.
