WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks has received notification of funding through the Bureau of Justice for the FFY2014 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program in the amount of \$36,041; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks has used federal and state JAG funds in combination to retain an officer in our local Statewide Drug Enforcement Unit (SDEU) for the purpose of conducting area-wide drug and alcohol investigations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks is not required to provide a match;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor is authorized to accept and execute any and all documents required for requesting and expending funds on behalf of the City for this project.


