A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO APPLY FOR FUNDS FROM THE ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE FFY2014 HAZARD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE GRANT

WHEREAS, the Alaska Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management provides funds for hazard mitigation projects that reduce the risk of future damage, hardship, loss, or suffering resulting from a major disaster; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks wishes to upgrade multiple City-owned facilities to be more resilient to natural disasters; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks wishes to request up to \$575,340; no match is required;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents required for requesting funds on behalf of the City for this grant.
