A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO APPLY FOR FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE FFY2014 STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER) GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security provides funds through the SAFER Grant Program to assist fire departments in increasing the number of firefighters to meet industry minimum standards; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks Fire Department has requested an increase in staffing for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, the SAFER Grant Program will provide funding for new firefighters for a period of two years and no match or retention of staff is required after the granting period; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks Fire Department wishes to increase its overall staffing by three firefighter positions per shift for a total of nine firefighters; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks wishes to request \$1,904,042 to hire nine firefighters;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required for requesting funds on behalf of the City for this grant and that <u>these positions will terminate</u> at the end of the granting period.
