**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO
ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE
FOR THE FFY2018 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE
ASSISTANCE GRANT**

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks received notification of funding through the Bureau of Justice Assistance for the FFY2018 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program in the amount of \$26,903 to support a range of program areas including law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks will use the funds to update and improve technology available to conduct and support major case and drug investigations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks is not required to provide a match.
