**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO APPLY FOR FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DOT&PF FOR THE ALASKA TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE GRANT PROGRAM FOR 5TH AVENUE SIDEWALKS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairbanks has been notified by the Alaska DOT&PF that the City is eligible to apply for Alaska Transportation Alternatives Grant Program (TAP) funds for projects defined as transportation alternatives; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairbanks plans to use the funds to complete the sidewalks and other non-motorized portions of the 5th Avenue Improvements project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairbanks plans to request \$585,000, and a match of \$52,830 is required.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required to request funds on behalf of the City for this grant.


