**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO APPLY
FOR FUNDS FROM THE ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND
SECURITY FOR THE FFY2019 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY
PROGRAM**


WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks has been notified by the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management that the City is eligible to apply for State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) funds to enhance resilience, absorb disruptions, and recover from incidents, both manmade and natural; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks plans to use the funds to purchase radios to complete replacement of our Alaska Land Mobile Radio (ALMR) subscriber units for the Fairbanks Police Department (\$75,000), advanced protection Network Firewall for the FECC (\$45,280), Instructor Fees and Backfill coverage for a Basic SWAT Course for FPD (\$12,000), instruction and backfill for area wide Rescue Task force training and exercise for FPD (\$8,000), and Collapse Rescue Class and Backfill Coverage for FPD (94,850); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks plans to request \$235,130, and no match is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required to request funds on behalf of the City for this grant.


