**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO
ACCEPT FUNDS FROM THE ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND
SECURITY FOR THE FFY2020 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY
PROGRAM**


WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks has been notified by the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management that the City of Fairbanks was awarded State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) funds to enhance resilience, absorb disruptions, and recover from incidents, both man-made and natural; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks was awarded \$89,000 to update the Police Station Back Lot Security (\$60,000), to purchase Battery Powered Positive Pressure Fans for the Fire Department (\$19,000), and for Engineering Training in post-earthquake structural assessment (\$10,000); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks is not required to provide a match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute all documents required for accepting grant funds on behalf of the City from the Alaska Division of Homeland Security FFY2020 State Homeland Security Program.
