**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO APPLY
FOR ALASKA MENTAL HEALTH TRUST AUTHORITY (AMHTA)
BEHAVIORAL HEALTH MINI GRANTS**

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks Reentry Coalition Coordinator wishes to apply for Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority (AMHTA) Behavioral Health Mini Grants on behalf of reentry participants (beneficiaries); and

WHEREAS, AMHTA allows municipal agencies to apply for Mini Grants on behalf of beneficiaries for awards made to and carried out by the applicant agency; and


WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks Reentry Coalition Coordinator wishes to apply for allowable expenses such as housing assistance, vehicle repairs, educational expenses, clothing, tools, and other items for reentry beneficiaries; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks is limited to three Mini Grant applications per month, for a total of 36 in a fiscal year, with applications limited to \$2,500 per beneficiary; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks does not bear responsibility for purchased goods once transferred to beneficiaries, and there is no match required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required for requesting funds on behalf of the City for this grant.


