WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks has been notified by the United States Department of Homeland Security that the City of Fairbanks is eligible to apply for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program to enhance operations and safety; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks plans to use the funds for training (\$29,000), overtime costs associated with attending the trainings (\$471,000), and an ambulance (\$350,000); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks plans to request \$850,000.00, and a 10% match is required; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks is providing a match in the amount of \$85,000.00, with \$35,000.00 from the Capital Fund and \$50,000.00 from the General Fund.
