**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO APPLY  
FOR FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF  
HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE FFY2023 ASSISTANCE TO  
FIREFIGHTERS GRANT (AFG)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairbanks has been notified by the United States Department of Homeland Security that the City of Fairbanks is eligible to apply for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program to enhance operations and safety; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairbanks plans to use the funds for training (\$29,000), overtime costs associated with attending the trainings (\$471,000), and an ambulance (\$350,000); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairbanks plans to request \$850,000.00, and a 10% match is required; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairbanks is providing a match in the amount of \$85,000.00, with \$35,000.00 from the Capital Fund and \$50,000.00 from the General Fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required for requesting funds on behalf of the City for this grant.
