WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks has been notified by the United States Department of Homeland Security that the City is eligible to apply for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program to enhance operations and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Fairbanks Fire Department plans to sign a Memorandum of Understanding with other fire departments in the region to participate in a regional AFG application; and

WHEREAS, the Fairbanks Fire Department's request under the regional application is to purchase five NFPA-compliant radios for command staff; and
