A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO APPLY FOR FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR A FFY2023 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT THROUGH A REGIONAL APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks has been notified by the United States Department of Homeland Security that the City is eligible to apply for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program to enhance operations and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Fairbanks Fire Department plans to sign a Memorandum of Understanding with other fire departments in the region to participate in a regional AFG application; and

WHEREAS, the Fairbanks Fire Department's request under the regional application is to purchase five NFPA-compliant radios for command staff; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to request \$34,500, and a 10% match is required; and

WHEREAS, the City will provide a match in the amount of \$3,450.00 from the department's General Fund Operating Supplies line item for these non-capital items; and

WHEREAS, the Capital City Fire/Rescue of Juneau, Alaska is coordinating the paperwork and submission requirements for this regional application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required for requesting funds on behalf of the City for the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Assistance to Firefighters grant.


