**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO
APPLY FOR FUNDS FROM THE ALASKA DIVISION OF
HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE FFY2022/2023 STATE AND
LOCAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (SLCGP)**

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks has been notified by the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management that the City is eligible to apply for State and local cybersecurity grant funds to assist local and tribal governments with managing and reducing systematic cyber risk; and

WHEREAS, eligible applicants can apply for up to three projects within established priorities, including improving cybersecurity incident management and response capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks plans to use the funds for the purchase of a security vulnerability management system (\$65,000) and for information technology disaster recovery planning (\$20,000); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks plans to request \$85,000, and no match is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required for requesting funds on behalf of the City for the Alaska Division of Homeland Security FFY2022/2023 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant.
